AGRICULTURE IN GOZO

THERE ARE 2,449 HECTARES OF UTILIZED LAND IN GOZO

According to the Gozo Regional Development Authority (June 2022), Gozitan farmers accounted for 2,617 hectares of land and most of this land is rented either from the government (44%) or private owners (22%).

Of the total utilized land, a small portion is used for kitchen gardens (396 hectares) and permanent crops (162 hectares)
